**AEROCARE MEDICAL TRANSPORT AND OMNI AIR TRANSPORT JOIN TOGETHER TO PROVIDE DEDICATED AIR AMBULANCE SERVICE**

**TULSA, OK – FEBRUARY 23, 2009** - Omni Air Transport, LLC and AeroCare Medical Transport are pleased to announce their new dedicated air ambulance program. The two Tulsa-based companies have joined together to provide air ambulance service across the country and the rest of the Western Hemisphere, using a medically-configured Learjet 35A aircraft.

AeroCare MT has provided air ambulance and transplant services in partnership with Omni for over 20 years. AeroCare MT employs the required medical staff including two Board-Certified Emergency Medical Physicians as Medical Directors, eight Registered Nurses, and fifteen Flight Paramedics. Their mission is to provide quality medical transport with the highest level of safety, professionalism and respect.

AeroCare MT's team of medical professionals is available on a 24-hour basis and has a response time of thirty minutes. AeroCare MT personnel will ensure referring and accepting physicians are apprised of any issues related to the patient as well as arrange licensed and authorized ground ambulance/transport services to and from health care facilities. The AeroCare MT teams include a Registered Nurse and paramedic equipped to respond to the needs of the patient.

Additionally, AeroCare MT has been accredited by the Commission of Accreditation of Medical Transport (CAMTS) since 2001, is a provider-member of the Association of Air Medical Services and meets all AAMS standards for fixed-wing air ambulance.

Omni was founded in Tulsa, Oklahoma in 1983, operating a single Learjet aircraft for purposes of charter and air ambulance. In 2004, Omni successfully completed its first Aviation Research Group (ARG/US) audit, making the company one of very few ARG/US Platinum charter operators in the United States. Today, the number of Platinum operators is less than six percent.

The ARG/US audit is an on-site, voluntary audit performed every two years focusing on all areas of the organization, from maintenance to flight operations. The highest possible rating that an operator is eligible to earn is the Platinum rating, which is awarded to "an operator who has demonstrated the implementation of industry best practices including a Safety Management System, a workable Emergency Response Plan, and appropriate written standards, training, and adequate historical records for all major aspects of Operations and Maintenance within the company." Omni, who operates a fleet of Learjets including two Learjet 45's, one Hawker 800XP, four Learjet 35A's and one Beechcraft Baron BE-58, was established in Tulsa in 1983 and provides on-demand charter, air ambulance services, cargo, aircraft management, and other special requests. The company has continued to grow since its inception in 1983, and maintains a reputation for safety, attention to detail, and world-class customer service ever since.
